# **Student Code of Conduct**



#### **Purpose**

This policy outlines the behaviour, safety, and participation standards expected of all students attending Combat Academy UK sessions. It is designed to ensure a safe, respectful, and positive training environment for everyone.

### **Attendance and Punctuality**

- Arrive on time for all classes.
- Inform your instructor in advance if you are unable to attend for a significant period.
- Remain in the training area until the session has ended and you are dismissed by an instructor.

### **Uniform and Equipment**

- Always wear the official uniform or appropriate clothing for training.
- Long hair must be tied back, jewellery removed, and no chewing gum during sessions.
- Wear appropriate protective equipment at all times, as instructed.
- Treat all equipment with respect.

### **Behaviour and Respect**

- Always behave respectfully towards instructors, fellow students, volunteers, and members of the public.
- Use appropriate language at all times.
- Do not engage in threatening or aggressive behaviour.
- Treat training partners with respect; all techniques and sparring should be controlled to avoid injury.
- Cooperate with instructors, team members, and opponents.
- Practice good sportsmanship; win with modesty and lose with dignity.
- Follow all instructions given by the instructor promptly and safely.

### Safeguarding and Safety

- Report any injuries, illnesses, or concerns to your instructor before the session starts.
- Stay within the designated training areas at all times.
- Follow all health & safety guidance provided by instructors.
- Abide by all safeguarding policies, including not taking photographs or videos of other students without permission.
- Understand that instructors are responsible for your safety during sessions, but you are expected to act responsibly and respectfully.

### **Participation and Effort**

- Work hard and give your best effort in every session.
- Focus on personal development, discipline, and skill improvement, not just grade or belt achievement.
- Support fellow students and celebrate their progress.
- Ask questions and seek guidance when unsure about techniques.

### **Membership and Licences**

- Keep your membership licence up to date.
- Pay training fees on time and in full.
- Understand that participation in sessions without a valid membership is not permitted.

#### **Club Culture**

- Promote a positive, respectful, and inclusive environment.
- Encourage teamwork, mutual respect, and personal responsibility.
- Respect the club facilities, equipment, and all members of the club community.
